



Notice of the 2022/2023 - 2023/2024 CHSP Public Meeting and Mandatory Application Workshop

The City of Tallahassee and Leon County invite all interested non-profit human service organizations to participate in the 2022/2023 - 2023/2024 funding cycle of the Community Human Service Partnership (CHSP) grant process. To apply for funding, the organization must provide direct human services to residents of the Tallahassee/Leon County area.

Each year, the City of Tallahassee and Leon County provide funding to non-profit human services organizations to provide safety net services to vulnerable citizens.

The primary mechanism for supporting human services is through the Community Human Services Partnership (CHSP) providing investment in a broad range of human service programs implemented by local non-profits. The City and County fund human services programs with general funds, supplemented by federal and state grants such as the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the American Rescue Plan Act from the Department of Treasury, as well as Change for Change (CFC), a utility customer donation program.

All agencies that intend to apply for the 2022/2023 - 2023/2024 funding cycle must attend ONE of the mandatory virtual workshops listed below. The deadline to register is Friday, February 25, 2022, at CHSPPortal.org.
